WIS 57 Resurfacing Project - W Silver Spring Drive to W Good Hope Road, Milwaukee County

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is proposing to resurface WIS 57 in Milwaukee County.

WisDOT will host a Public Involvement Meeting (PIM) for the proposed project on WIS 57 (W. Green Bay Avenue) from W. Silver Spring Drive to W. Good Hope Road in the city of Glendale, Milwaukee County.

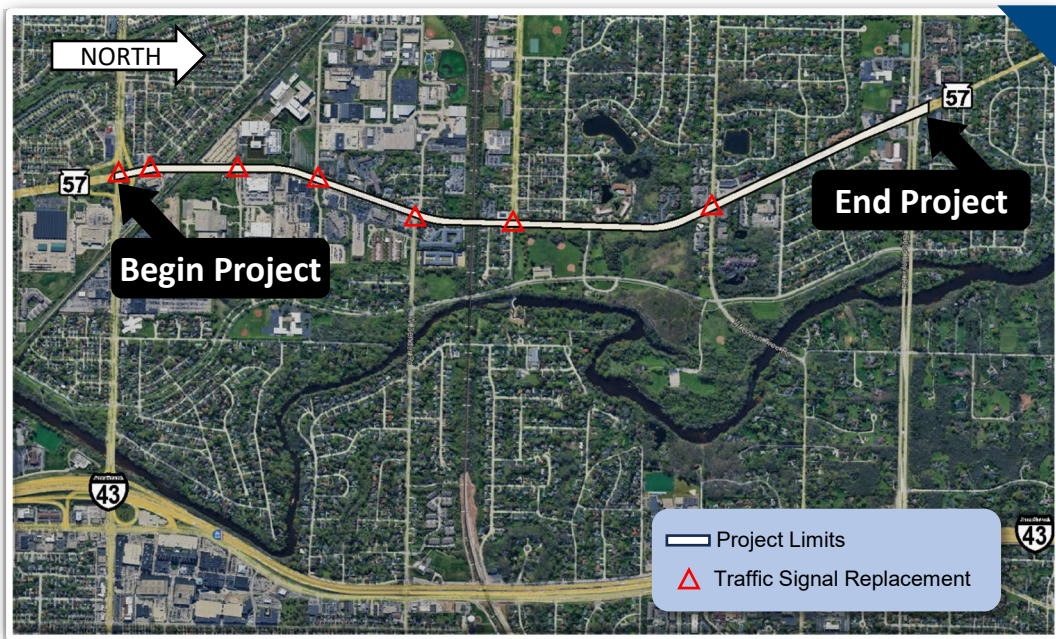
Proposed Improvements:

- Mill and resurface 2.2 miles of asphaltic surface
- Replace the existing 5-foot sidewalk along the east side of the roadway with a 10-foot shared-use path
 - Connection to Oak Leaf Trail
- Spot sidewalk additions on the west side of roadway
- Upgrade pedestrian curb ramps to Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards where feasible
- Realignment of Marne Avenue intersection
- Seven (7) traffic signal replacements
- Minor maintenance of drainage structures
- New signing and pavement markings

Traffic Impacts

- Traffic staging options are still being evaluated

Construction is anticipated for 2030,
or 2029 if funding becomes available
