Approval of Minutes of previous meeting:

Paul moved to approve the minutes, and Eric seconded. Motion passed.

SRO Annual Review:

The chief reported that he talked to the Nicolet Principal, Joe Patek, and he was very positive about Officer Myers and the SRO program. Mr. Patek said Officer Myers connects well with the students and understands her unique role. She wrote a safety plan the school is very happy with. Mr. Patek said he couldn't think of any area in which she could improve. Officer Myers gives her weekly reports, and those reports don't fully account for what she's done, because much of it is not quantifiable (for example, prevention of problems). The chief said the PD is also very happy with her in this position. Paul asked how it's determined whether a disciplinary problem is handled by the SRO versus school administration. The chief said that when it's a safety issue, like a fight with an assault, it's the SRO. When it comes to things like vaping, alcohol, etc., there is a discussion between the administration and the officer. Chief Fugman said we are careful to make sure the SRO is acting on behalf of Glendale Police Department, not just doing whatever the school wants.

Interviews:

Paul moved and Lars seconded that we go into closed session for police-officer-candidate interviews. Motion passed.

Lars moved that we return to open session. Paul seconded. Motion passed.

Paul moved that we pursue hiring both of the police-officer candidates we interviewed tonight. Lars seconded. Motion passed.

Our next meeting is not scheduled. Lars moved that we wait to set the date (probably in September) until we have candidates to interview. Paul seconded. Motion passed.

Lars moved the we adjourn. Paul seconded. Motion passed.
